Connect & Review

1. How do you respond when things are “unfair” in your life? Can you name a recent time when you’ve experienced this? How did it affect you?

Investigate & Dig

2. Review: What was the main message Jesus communicated in 15:11-24?
3. Now read Luke 15:25-32. What is the main message Jesus is communicating here?
4. Why does the older brother become so angry with the Father? What does this reveal about him? Do you sympathize with him? Why or why not?
5. In what way is the older brother just as lost as the younger brother? Why is it so easy to fall into the same trap in our lives when it comes to our relationship with God?
6. What does the father in this story try to communicate to the older son? What did the Father communicate to you? Why does Jesus end the message the way He does?

Apply & Respond

7. What does this story tell us about God’s heart? Do you share God’s heart when it comes to people far from Him? Why or why not?
8. Is sharing your faith with someone a duty or a joy? How can this story encourage us to see it as a joy?
9. Take time to pray together and be honest with the Father about your heart and your heart for others. Continue to pray for your “one” & share any updates on how the Spirit is moving!
