

1. Even if you're not married, what are some of the biggest differences you've noticed between men and women?

Investigate & Dig

1. Read **1 Peter 3:1-7**. What most stands out to you in Peter's words to husbands in this verse?
2. What four commands does Peter give to husbands on how they are to treat their wives? Do any confuse, surprise, or encourage you?
3. If you are a husband, be honest and share which of these you need to work on and why.
4. Is it easy for you to pray with other people? Why or why not? Why might that be something we should pursue whether we are married or not?
5. How would you define love? How is the world's understanding of love different from the Biblical view of love?
6. Explain the paradox principle in your own words. How is this true for any relationship?
7. Read **Ephesians 5:21-33**. What does Paul say about marriage in these verses? How does Paul connect marriage to Christ and the church?
8. Husbands and wives in the group, what is one area Jesus is calling you to lay down in your life to help your spouse thrive? How can the group help?
