Generation X (1 Corinthians 12:12-27)  
Life Group Questions – May 23, 2021



## Connect & Review

1. As the GenXers in your group what it was like to grow up during that time. Strongest memories, the mood of the time, favorite things, etc. If you're from an older generation, how do you view these years? If you're from a younger generation, how do you view these years?
2. Why do you believe this generation is described with words like: cynical, skeptical, isolated and individual?

## Investigate & Dig

1. Read **Joshua 24:15**. What is the context of this verse? Why could this verse be applied to Generation X? How does it strike you?
2. Read **1 Corinthians 12:12-27**. What metaphor does Paul use to describe the Church here? What other metaphors are used in the Bible to describe the Church?
3. What does it mean that we are the *body* of Christ? Why might this be an especially important thing for GenXers to remember?
4. What does interdependence mean? If you are a GenXer: do you struggle with interdependence? Why might it be a temptation for this generation to avoid it? Why is it so important though?
5. What happens if GenXers (every generation really) do not take their role as a "member of the body" seriously? Are you taking it seriously? If not, why? If so, how?

**Respond:** Take time to pray for the Gen X generation, thanking God for them. Ask the Lord to show you what your next step is in joining the Body of Christ in the mission God has given. If you are part of another generation, ask the Lord to show you how you can encourage this generation.
