Connect & Review

Who is your favorite character in the Bible (not Jesus) and why? What did you learn from them?

Investigate & Dig

1. Read 1 Kings 16:29-33 to be reminded of the context of Elijah's story. What stands out to you as you read that Scripture?
2. Read 1 Kings 17:1. Put yourself in Elijah's shoes. Since he was human just like us, what thoughts do you think were going through His mind?
3. Read 1 Kings 17:2-6. Review why God directed Elijah to go to Kerith? Have you experienced any "Kerith" moments or seasons in your life? Describe them if you can? What thoughts did you have about God and about your situation?
4. Why do we not see our "Keriths" as gifts from God used to develop our dependence on Him?
5. Read 2 Corinthians 12:8-10. Why do we not delight in our weaknesses?
6. Is it easy or hard for you to have 1 day at a time faith? Why?
7. Are there any areas in life where you are struggling to believe the promises of God right now?
8. What is God asking you to do in response to this teaching?
