Life Group Questions – June 13, 2021



Connect & Review

1. When is a time you know that God was testing you?
2. Why does God put us through these tests of faith (see **James 1:2-4**)?

Investigate & Dig

1. Read **1 Kings 17:7-9**. What test was God giving Elijah here? Why would this particular ask have been humbling and surprising to him?
2. Have you ever faced “the test of change” (this is more than just about moving!)? When/how? How did you respond?
3. Read **1 Kings 17:10-14**. Why would Elijah’s request have been so challenging to this widow? What excuses could she have made to not follow through? What excuses can we use when God asks us to step out in faith?
4. Read **1 Kings 17:15**. What is the final test both Elijah and this widow must go through? How does she respond? What does this tell us about how and when God provides?
5. How do faith and obedience interact in the life of the believer? Are there any areas in your life you know the Lord is asking you to step out in faith and obey? What holds you back?
6. What does it mean to you that God is *Jehovah Jireh*? How can you take that promise into your faith life today?

Respond

Spend time sharing *one thing* you know God is asking you to step out in faith in and pray for the person to your left for the strength and courage to do so, trusting God will provide!
