## Connect & Review

What is the first thing you think of when you hear the word “prayer” or when you think about praying?

## Investigate & Dig

1. Read 1 Kings 18:41-46.

2. What stood out to you in the message or in the re-reading of this Scripture? *Leader – this may be the entirety of your conversation this week. That’s ok! It’s good to listen and respond to the Word of God.*

3. When you encounter difficult situations or circumstances, do you tend to focus on the situation or on God’s faithfulness and promises? Why?

4. Is it difficult for you to pray persistently? Is there anything you have given up praying for because it has taken so long to get an answer?

5. Do you pray and then forget about what you prayed, or do you pray and then anticipate God’s answer and pay attention for evidences of God at work?

6. As you pray, do you find yourself sometimes wanting the gift more than the Giver?

7. What is God asking you to do in response to this teaching?
