Investigate & Dig

- 1. Read 1 Kings 18:41-46.
- 2. What stood out to you in the message or in the re-reading of this Scripture? Leader this may be the entirety of your conversation this week. That's ok! It's good to listen and respond to the Word of God.
- 3. When you encounter difficult situations or circumstances, do you tend to focus on the situation or on God's faithfulness and promises? Why?
- 4. Is it difficult for you to pray persistently? Is there anything you have given up praying for because it has taken so long to get an answer?
- 5. Do you pray and then forget about what you prayed, or do you pray and then anticipate God's answer and pay attention for evidences of God at work?
- 6. As you pray, do you find yourself sometimes wanting the gift more than the Giver?
- 7. What is God asking you to do in response to this teaching?
