Connect & Review

1. How have you been confronted with injustice recently (in either a small or big way) and what did you do?

Investigate & Dig

1. In many ways, life here on earth can be characterized as a battle between trusting the Kingdom of God and the Kingdom of this world, between coveting and cultivating. What is God teaching you about “not wanting” (Psalm 23:1)?
2. Have each member of the group look up the different verses under the second line in the message notes and have a conversation about what scripture has to say on the topics of coveteousness & cultivation. Share what you notice.
4. God’s heart towards injustice is that He grieves it, confronts it & experiences it. Do you agree or disagree? What questions does it bring to your mind if any?
5. Do you agree that the church here in the States, especially in the suburbs, struggles with lament? What does lament look like in your life?
6. Is standing for justice something you feel comes easy to you or is more difficult and why? How do we move beyond divisiveness and towards action in this area?

Respond

Share whether you feel more like an Ahab, a Naboth or a combination after this message and why.

Spend time in prayer for one another, our city, our nation concerning issue of justice. Pray for God’s Kingdom to come and for the church to have eyes to see how she can continue to join God in the work of reconciliation.
