It is our privilege to celebrate the important spiritual marker of baptism. Today we're baptizing people in both services. Why do we baptize? And what does it mean? Here are 4 reasons we value baptism...

- Desus commands us to be baptized. He said baptism is a mark of every true disciple (Matt. 28:19). As His grateful followers—those who've received His amazing grace and forgiveness—we now gladly obey Jesus by choosing to be baptized. It's not so much a "have to," as it is a "get to" and a "want to" for us. The pattern in Scripture is people believed and were baptized (Acts 4:37-41). Today, we celebrate as these followers of Jesus take the next step of obedience in baptism.
- ②Jesus Himself was baptized. It's inspiring to know that Jesus—the only sinless person to ever walk this earth—began His earthly ministry at 30 years of age by asking John the Baptist to baptize Him. When John protested, Jesus insisted, "We must carry out all God requires." (Matt. 3:15). Jesus never asks you to do anything He's not willing to do.
- ❸ Baptism is a picture of trust. We practice baptism by immersion (which means to "place completely under" water) because that's the literal meaning of the word. As you go back, under & then up out of the water, you illustrate your trust in all Jesus has DONE in His death, burial & resurrection (Ro. 6:3-4) and all He will DO with you.
- Baptism is a witness to others. Being baptized is a great opportunity to point others to Jesus and to declare, "I have decided to follow Jesus." In some places of the world, if you choose to be baptized, it may cost you the loss of family, friends, job or even your life. Baptism is a chance to go public, & be unashamed of Jesus (Matt. 10:32-33).
