1. When you pray, is there a consistent title that you use to address God? Why do you use that title?

Learn

2. This weekend was the beginning of a new series called "Who Is This God?" What excites you about this new series?

Read Together:

And he [God] passed in front of Moses, proclaiming, "The LORD [Yahweh], the LORD [Yahweh], the compassionate and gracious God, slow to anger, abounding in love and faithfulness, maintaining love to thousands, and forgiving wickedness, rebellion and sin. Yet he does not leave the guilty unpunished; he punishes the children and their children for the sin of the parents to the third and fourth generation." Exodus 34:6-7

- 4. What did you learn about God's name from the sermon this week? What stood out to you? Many times answering this questions reveals how God was speaking to you.
- 5. What one (or more) of the applications from the message is God impressing on you?
