1. What are some things that make you angry? Some may even be funny!

Learn and Apply

2. Before listening to the message how would you have described the anger of God in your own words? How do you view God?

Read Together:

And he [God] passed in front of Moses, proclaiming, "The LORD [Yahweh], the LORD [Yahweh], the compassionate and gracious God, slow to anger, abounding in love and faithfulness, maintaining love to thousands, and forgiving wickedness, rebellion and sin. Yet he does not leave the guilty unpunished; he punishes the children and their children for the sin of the parents to the third and fourth generation." Exodus 34:6-7

- 3. What did you learn about the anger of God from the message this week?
- 4. Discuss God's passive anger. How do you see that in the world today? How can God's passive anger actually be his compassion and grace to those who have chosen to go their own way?
- 5. Read the following passages in the Bible (assign different people in the group to read): Psalm 37:8; Prov. 14:29, 15:18, 22:24-25, 29:11, 29:22, James 1:19-20. What do you learn from these verses?
- 6. Share any areas where you need to ask God to help you with your anger. What situations do you recognize in your life that lead to anger?
