Verse 1 (*Isaiah 7:14*): O come, O come, Emmanuel, and ransom captive Israel. That mourns in lonely exile here, until the Son of God appear.

Verse 2 (*Isaiah 11:2-3*): O come, Thou Wisdom from on high. Who orderest all things mightily; To us the path of knowledge show and teach us in her ways to go.

Verse 3 (*Isiah 11*): O come, Thou Rod (root) of Jesse, free, thine own from Satan's tyranny; From depths of hell Thy people save, and give them victory over the grave.

Verse 4 (*Isaiah 9:2*): O come, Thou Day-spring, come and cheer, our spirits by Thine advent here. Disperse the gloomy clouds of night, and death's dark shadows put to flight.

Verse 5 (*Isaiah 22:22*): O come, Thou Key of David, come. And open wide our heavenly home. Make safe the way that leads on high, and close the path to misery.

Verse 6 (*Isaiah 33:22*): O come, O come, great Lord of might. Who to Thy tribes on Sinai's height. In ancient times once gave the law, in cloud and majesty and awe.

Verse 7 (*Haggai 2:7/Isaiah 2:4*): O come, Desire of nations, bind. In one the hearts of all mankind; Bid Thou our sad divisions cease, and be Thyself our King of Peace.

Refrain: Rejoice! Rejoice! Emmanuel shall come to thee, O Israel.
