3. Which of the three “myths” of money do you most often find yourself falling in danger of? Why do you think that is?
4. Read **1 Timothy 6:6-10**. Is money evil? If not, what lesson does Paul want to teach here? Have you ever seen this happen to someone? To yourself?
5. Read **1 Timothy 6:17-19**. What is Paul’s wisdom here? Is this easy or difficult to do, especially as American Christians? Read **Matthew 6:19-20**. How can we practically start to think more about investing eternally as Jesus followers today?
