- *Temple* = a visual aid of God’s \_\_\_\_\_ & \_\_\_\_\_. Ex 25:21-22; John 2:19-22
- *Remembering* = \_\_\_\_\_ & \_\_\_\_\_ to your heart. Lam 3:19-23

therefore I will **remember** You. **Psalm 42:6**

On my bed I **remember** You;  
I think of You through the watches of the night.  
Because You are my help,  
I sing in the shadow of Your wings. I cling to You;  
Your right hand upholds me. **Psalm 63:6-8**

I **remember** my affliction and my wandering,  
the bitterness and the gall. I well **remember** them,

The steadfast love of the LORD never ceases;  
His mercies never come to an end;  
They are new every morning;
