God The Holy Spirit

Three distinctions: the gift of the Spirit, the fruit of the Spirit, the gifts from the Spirit

The Gift Of The Holy Spirit

Acts 2:38 describes the Holy Spirit Himself as a gift. He's given the moment we, as sinners, place our faith in Jesus Christ. He comes to indwell us, uniting us to Jesus forever. Jesus promised the coming of the Holy Spirit (John 14:16-17, 26; 15:26; 16:7-15; Acts 1:4-8; 2:1-4). He called the Holy Spirit our Helper or Advocate. We're baptized by the Holy Spirit one time, the moment we're saved, and He can never be taken away. But we need to be filled/controlled by Him continually (Ephesians 5:18).

The Fruit Of The Spirit

Is Christlike character qualities: love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness & self-control (Galatians 5:22-23). These virtues are produced within us by the power of the Holy Spirit who lives in us.

The Gifts From The Spirit

All believers, now having the Holy Spirit, have also been given spiritual gifts from the Holy Spirit. A gift from the Holy Spirit is a special skill or ability which enables each believer to contribute to the whole body of Christ with joy and effectiveness. As gifts, they cannot be earned. Our responsibility and privilege is to discover and exercise these gifts for the benefit of the church.
