On Sunday, February 15 (6-8pm), I am hosting our first Thinking Biblically About... forum where I will be addressing the topic: Thinking Biblically about...Immigration. I wanted to provide a little more detail about what it is and what to expect.

This forum was birthed out of the summer book club I have led for over 10 years now, where we read and then discuss books that are addressing various "hot topics" in the culture, church, or wider society. It has been an awesome (and challenging) experience to be able to sit down face-to-face with others and civilly discuss different topics together even when we disagree.

I was encouraged by the group this past summer to try to find a way to bring that experience to the whole church, hence these forums.

I am passionate about providing space in the church for meaningful discussion because right now our country is so polarized and uses such extreme rhetoric about everything (including in the church), that civil discussion has all but disappeared. Instead, people yell at each other hiding behind screens and the polarization continues to grow.

As Jesus' church, we can and should do better.

So, these forums are a space for us to consider various controversial topics together from a biblical perspective.

Here's what you can expect: The forums will consist of a 30-45-minute teaching from stage where the topic will be presented from various viewpoints, then we will break out into table groups for further discussion with guided questions. These discussions will have some "rules" to them, but my hope is these table groups will help us grow in our ability to disagree (or agree) with civility, humility, and love and listen to other people's perspectives.

Brothers and sisters, I truly hope these forums can be a place where we live counter-culturally by giving the world an example of what it means to agree/disagree with others in a civil and Christ-honoring way. Hope to see you there.
