On March 29, we are celebrating baptisms! If this is something you have been considering as a next step in your faith and you wonder why we baptize the way we do, here are a few things to consider:

Jesus commands us to be baptized. He said baptism is a mark of every true disciple (Matt. 28:19). As His grateful followers—those who've received His amazing grace and forgiveness—we now gladly obey Jesus by choosing to be baptized. The pattern in Scripture is people believed and were baptized (Acts 4:37-41). This is why we practice believer's baptism, while recognizing the importance and meaning of child dedication.



Jesus Himself was baptized. It's inspiring to know that Jesus—the only sinless person to ever walk this earth—began His earthly ministry at 30 years of age by asking John the Baptist to baptize Him. When John protested, Jesus insisted, "We must carry out all God requires." (Matt. 3:15). Jesus never asks you to do anything He's not willing to do. This is a tangible way we follow Him.

Baptism is a picture of the gospel. We practice baptism by immersion (which means to "place completely under" water) because that's the literal meaning of the word, and it is also a beautiful picture of the gospel: as you are immersed, you are dying to your old self, and as you are raised, you are "resurrected" into new life with Christ.

Baptism is a witness to others. Being baptized is a great opportunity to point others to Jesus and to declare, "I have decided to follow Jesus." In some places of the world, if you choose to be baptized, it may cost you the loss of family, friends, job or even your life. Baptism is a chance to go public & be unashamed of Jesus (Matt. 10:32-33).
