Cherry Hills Family,

On Father's Day, we pause to give thanks to God for fathers and for the significant role they play in shaping lives, families, and faith. Scripture calls fathers to reflect something of God's own heart—marked by love, faithfulness, humility, and care. While the Bible presents many imperfect fathers, it consistently points us toward a vision of fatherhood centered on responsibility, presence, and devotion to the Lord.

Throughout Scripture, fathers are called not simply to provide, but to guide and instruct. Deuteronomy reminds God's people to pass faith from one generation to the next through everyday faithfulness—through words spoken at home, through example, and through a life oriented toward God. In the New Testament, fathers are encouraged to raise their children with patience, wisdom, and grace, reflecting the character of Christ rather than control or fear. These callings remind us that fatherhood is not about perfection, but about steady, faithful care over time.

At the same time, we recognize that Father's Day can be complex. For some, it brings gratitude and joy; for others, it surfaces loss, disappointment, absence, or longing. Some grieve fathers who are no longer with them. Others carry pain from relationships that were strained or broken. Still others step into fatherly roles without formal titles, quietly offering love, guidance, and protection. In all of this, Scripture assures us that God is "a father to the fatherless" (Psalm 68:5), attentive to every story and near to those who carry heavy hearts.

Today, we honor fathers of all kinds and give thanks for the many ways God works through them—often in ordinary, unseen acts of faithfulness. We also entrust ourselves to our heavenly Father, whose love is constant, whose mercy is wide, and whose care never falters. May we continue to encourage one another toward lives that reflect His grace and truth.
