Position Description:

This person will be responsible for overseeing and helping to facilitate corporate worship for our Middle School & High School ministries. The student worship director will be primarily responsible for building an infrastructure that supports corporate worship in both our Wednesday evening (MSM) and Sunday evening (HSM) gatherings. They will also be responsible for building a culture and a leadership pipeline that equips and empowers younger artists to use their gifts at Cherry Hills. This position will report directly to our Student Pastor.

All staff is expected to display a Christ-like character when interacting with each other, church members, and guests as well as understand and fully support the Cherry Hills vision and culture. This individual will demonstrate a belief in and relationship with Jesus Christ and will affirm that they will provide for their own continued spiritual health & growth.

Student Worship Duties:

- Lead worship and/or delegate a leader on Wednesday & Sunday evenings.
- Lead worship and/or delegate a leader for all camps, retreats and additional events.
- Oversee all volunteer recruitment, training, and onboarding including team auditions and expectations.
- Work with Student Pastor to plan and debrief weekly gatherings.
- Schedule and attend regular student leadership and brainstorming meetings.
- Oversee Planning Center Online for both Middle School and High School gatherings.
- Work with the Technical Director to keep equipment in student spaces up to date.
- Prep or delegate prep for all technology for weekly gatherings including lyrics for ProPresenter, stage set, audio settings, etc.
- Offer leadership to the student lead team in both MSM and HSM.
- Invest in the character and competency of the volunteers in student worship ministry.
- Shepherd the volunteers in Middle and High School by being present and available to students as needs arise and time allows.
- Work with the worship arts pastor to help transition student volunteers to the Sunday morning adult team when they are ready.
- Help with Sunday morning worship as needed (typically once per month).
- Participate in worship team meetings & creative shares as assigned by Worship Pastor.

Qualifications:

- Will possess, or be working towards an accredited Bachelor's degree in worship leadership, biblical studies, vocal performance, instrumental performance, audio/visual technology, multimedia, or other appropriate field.
- Personal familiarity with and experience in worship leadership (e.g., playing a lead instrument while singing is a strongly preferred asset).
- Familiarity with digital sound boards and experience working with them whether mixing and/or operating.
- Familiarity patching stage.
- Familiarity with service management software (e.g., Planning Center Online) and digital audio workstations (e.g., Ableton, Logic Pro, Pro Tools, etc.).
- Prior experience on a worship team in a church setting as a volunteer.
- Demonstrated experience in leadership/program oversight and working with volunteers.
- Will have an eye/ear for artistic communication, not only what is relevant but what is artful and what calls our people deeper.
- A natural self-starter.
- Eager to learn and take on new and varied responsibilities.
- The ability to work on a team, communicate effectively, collaborate with multiple team members and take direction and feedback.
- The ability to work on many projects at once and hit deadlines.
- Excited about Cherry Hills Church and what we're running after.
