## Learning from Job

◆ Job is a man of \_\_\_\_\_ moral \_\_\_\_\_. (Ezk 14:14, 20; Jms 5:11)

Job was blameless and upright; he feared God & shunned evil. **Job 1:1**

## Suffering and God
