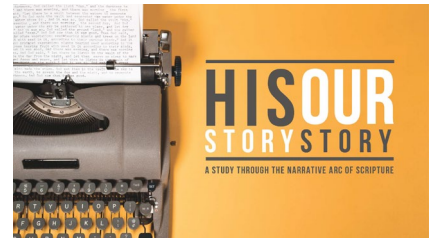


His Story – Our Story

Connect & Review

1. What would you say is the most important day of your life? Why?
2. Review *The Story* so far together. Where have we been?
3. Why is the Exodus the most referred to event in Israel's history? Why do the New Testament writers refer to it so often as well? How is it a pattern of God's redemption?

Investigate & Dig

4. **Read Exodus 13:1 & 14:4, 17-18.** *Why* does God redeem His people? How is this similar to the reason Jesus redeemed us?
5. **Read Exodus 13:17-4:3 and 14:10-12.** *How* does God redeem His people? When is a time when it has been difficult for you to trust God's path for you? What can this story teach us about these times in our lives?
6. **Read Exodus 14:13-14.** *What* does God do to redeem His people? How is this similar to **Ephesians 2:8-9** and **Romans 4:5**?

Apply & Respond

7. How should our redemption change the way we live?
8. What are some ways you "commemorate" the Lord's work in your life? What would it look like for you to remember what He has done?
9. Why are God's people a celebrating people? Is this true of your life? Why or why not?
10. How can the group pray for you? Take time to pray for one another.
