


His Story – Our Story

Connect & Review

1. Share a highlight from your last week with your group.
2. **Read 2 Samuel 7:1-16.** Why is the idea of Kingdom important at this point in the story? What do we learn about God or ourselves through Kingdom?
3. How does the connection of different promises in scripture (Abraham, David, Jesus) help or hinder you? Why?
4. What does it mean to be a part of God's Family? Why is this important?

Investigate & Dig

5. If the Kingdom of God is the "Forever Family of God trusting the Forever Father," what does that "family-like" trust look like for you specifically?
6. When is it hard for you to choose to participate in God's Kingdom/family as opposed to the "kingdom of the world"? Why is it hard for you?

Apply & Respond

7. The Kingdom of God is more about heaven getting into us than us getting into heaven (The Lord's the prayer: "Your Kingdom come, Your will be done"). What does this mean to you? How does it affect what you do tomorrow? Share a specific thing you will do in response to this message.
8. How can the group pray for you regarding Kingdom? Take time to pray for one another.
