- 4. What responsibility comes with knowing our identity?
- 5. Read Isaiah 43:20—21, Isaiah 60:21, Matthew 28:18-20, and Ephesians 1:3—6, Ephesians 2:10. What do you learn about God's purposes in the world and in you?
- 6. We are chosen by God to partner with Him to expand the Kingdom. How does that make you feel?

- 7. What did you learn about God and about yourself from Sunday's teaching?
- 8. If you had to write a mission statement for your life, what would it sound like?
- 9. How can you practically live on mission with God to expand the Kingdom this week? In other words (**1 Peter 2:9**), in what ways can God's people declare the praises or excellencies of God?
